Requests must be **postmarked by May 30, 2019**. An administration fee will be charged for all cancellations requested after May 30, 2019.

For those commissioners and officials unable to attend for the full conference, there are one and two day plans shown on the reverse side of the Registration Form.

Pre/Post Conference Registration Options:

Commissioners and officials desiring to extend your stay at the Wyndham Gettysburg Hotel for either pre-conference or post conference can choose this option.
