Lower Paxton Township Launches New Website

Lower Paxton Township, PA – Lower Paxton Township announced the launch of an upgraded Township website today. The Township partnered with CivicPlus, an integrated technology platform for local government, using the CivicEngage tool, and together have created an easy to navigate site that brings the Township to the next level of technology for staff and residents, alike.

“The Board of Supervisors was pleased to be able to work with CivicPlus to launch such a dynamic website for our residents and guests. The Township’s Communications staff has been hard at work planning, designing, and now implementing the updated website that users will find it to be vastly improved. This site is a great step forward in the Board’s continued efforts to communicate with residents,” stated Brad Gotshall, Township Manager.

Highlights of new site include:

- Mobile optimized design** that ensures citizens can easily navigate and interact with content from any desktop computer, smartphone, or tablet, anytime and anywhere.
- The highest data security standards backed by a team of cybersecurity experts.** CivicPlus offers 99.7% up-time in a tier II data center that is fully redundant, the support of multiple network providers, burst band-width, disaster recovery via geographically diverse data centers and defined RTO and RPO, and live 24/7/365 emergency support.
- Calendar functionality** allows citizens to stay informed about the scheduling of important local events, including public meetings, classes, activities, community events, and other valuable opportunities for engagement.
- Agenda Center** allows for the storing, sharing, and searching of public meetings and agendas and enables citizens to remain informed and engaged in public policy and local issues.
- Personalized logins** allow citizens to create an account associated with the website so that it becomes a personalized tool to download forms, submit applications and permits, pay bills, submit and track inquiries, comment on stories and topics of interests, and further engage in public dialog (*several of these tools will be integrated over time and are still being designed*).

For users that visited the former site frequently, the Township suggests clearing your cache on your computer/tablet or smartphone and re-typing the link. The site will then load properly, otherwise the site could appear offline.
