Bridges Across the Country

The American Jobs Plan will direct funding to 10,000 of the smallest bridges:

Find the bridges close to you:

- ✓ By Congressional district and state: <https://artbabridgereport.org/congressional/map>
 - Use the navigational panel on the right side to search state or Congressional district
- ✓ By state: <https://infobridge.fhwa.dot.gov/>
 - Click data
 - Click “State Name” on the right hand side
 - Select state in the pop up menu
 - Click “show bridges”
 - People can then sort by county in the fourth column
 - And then sort by bridge condition in the thirteenth column
