Enacted Legislation

Act Number	Approved/Vetoed	Act Summary
Act 1	Approved by the Governor, 2/5/21 Effective 2/5/21	This Act amends The Fiscal Code, providing for the appropriation and program requirements associated with COVID-19 Relief dollars allocated to the Commonwealth via United States House Resolution 133, known as the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021.
Act 4	Approved by the Governor, 3/3/21 Effective 3/3/21	This Act amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) removing the public health duties from the power of the governor and providing that the Pennsylvania National Guard, in conjunction with the Department of Health and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency, may develop plans for the establishment and operation of community distribution and administration of pharmaceuticals, medical equipment and supplies and vaccines for a virus. It provides for reporting requirements on the integration of the Pennsylvania National Guard into the Commonwealth's vaccine distribution and administration plan.
Act 21	Approved by the Governor, 6/11/21 Effective 6/11/21	This Act amends the Administrative Code requires that executive agencies preserve all records relating to the orders of a declaration of disaster emergency issued by the Governor relating to COVID-19. The preservation of records under this legislation shall conform with an executive agency's existing record retention policy. Also, it provides for a 90-day extension to the suspension of a regulatory statute, order, rule or regulation that was previously suspended under the COVID-19 emergency declaration. The suspension of these regulatory statutes, orders, rules or regulations will be in effect until September 30, 2021, unless sooner terminated by the authority which initially authorized the suspension.
